NOTES:

Students must earn a grade of C (2.0) or above in each course taken for a major or minor in the Department of French and Francophone Studies.

- 1) *Three courses at the FREN 300 level and above, one of which must be at the 400+ level and one must be taken at the Tacoma campus during the senior year. At least three of the following French courses: FREN 220, 260, 270, 330, 340, and 391. FREN 280, 350, 380, and 480 may count toward this requirement with approval of the department chair.
- 2) Of the three units of upper division coursework required outside the first major, the Connections course will count for one unless it is used to meet a major requirement.

#Study abroad to be completed in a French speaking country where French is the language of instruction. Exceptions to the semester study abroad requirement may be made on a case-by-case basis in a petition to the department and in consultation with a department academic advisor. Language-intensive replacements may include a year living in a French theme house, intensive summer study, etc.

##Seniors must work with their advisor in the French and Francophone Studies department to create an ePortfolio about their progress in the curriculum and total experience as a major; to be submitted to the department by April 15 of senior year.

###All Francophone Cultural Studies majors must submit a senior paper to the department by April 15 of their senior year. Details available on the department homepage.
