

**Curriculum Committee Minutes
September 5, 2001**

Present: Barry, Beck, Clark, Derryberry, Hannaford, Kerrick, Kline, Kontogeorgopoulos, Mehlhaff, Neff-Lippman, Pasco-Pranger, Sable, Sackman, Tomhave, Warning (chair), Washburn, Weinman.

Barry called the meeting to order at 8:00 a.m.

Warning was elected chair of the Committee for Fall 2001.

Pasco-Pranger was elected secretary of the Committee for Fall 2001.

Minutes were approved for 5/1/01.

Barry reviewed actions for which the Committee traditionally delegates authority to the Associate Dean.

Action: Hannaford M/S/P delegation of said authority.

Washburn reviewed the 2001-2002 business of the Committee and asked for Committee members' preferences in subcommittee assignments. She also pointed out that she had provisionally combined old and new core categories that are likely to have substantial overlap into one subcommittee (e.g., Mathematical Reasoning combined with the Mathematic Way of Knowing); she asked whether the Committee thought this would be okay. Pasco-Pranger pointed out that this combination of categories would be useful since some courses will have to count for Core credit in both the old and new core as we make the transition between them. Mehlhaff asked what effect approving courses for the new core would have now if the new core is not to be implemented until Fall 2003. Barry answered that it would have the desirable effect of spreading out the Committee's workload. Mehlhaff asked whether courses approved for the new Core would be publicized as such. Barry answered that they would not be so publicized until registration for Fall 2003; freshman enrolling in Fall 2003 will be the first students to use the new Core.

The Committee reviewed and grudgingly accepted Washburn's choice of Wednesdays at 8:00 a.m. as its meeting time for Fall 2001.
