

Minutes of the Library, Media, and Academic Computing Committee

May 1, 1996, Student Union Building 101, 12 p.m.

The committee reviewed Hanson's draft of the committee's final report to the faculty senate and made suggestions for improvement. In the area of possible agenda items for next year, the committee added the following: library collections and space issues and the idea of a university-wide electronic calendar and reservation system.

The committee then discussed the results of the LMAC Faculty Survey on Use of Computer Technology, reviewing the list of frequencies produced by Raney Ellis.

The committee also discussed the future of the LMAC. There was an informal consensus that in the absence of a clear mission or any real administrative power the LMAC should probably be dissolved.

The year's final meeting was adjourned at 12:55 after committee members expressed their appreciation for John Hanson's fine work as committee chair.
