- 1) Majors may satisfy no more than two university core requirements from African American Studies offerings.
- 2) AFAM 101 is prerequisite to AFAM 201.
- 3) AFAM 201 is prerequisite to AFAM 399.
- 4) Four elective units, including two depth and two breadth courses, selected and approved through advising from the courses listed in the Bulletin. At least three of the four units must be taken at the 300+ level.
- 5) Of the three units of upper division coursework required outside the first major, the Connections course will count for one unless it is used to meet a major requirement.
- 6) Only courses for which a student has received a C- or better may count for the major or minor.
- 7) Students who study abroad may apply two approved courses toward their African American Studies major.
