Tax Information

This year the **TAX DAY** is April 15, 2014.

All nonresident aliens present in the U.S. under F-1, F-2, J-1, or J-2 nonimmigrant status must file Form 8843 "Statement for Exempt Individuals and Individuals With a Medical Condition"—even if they received NO income during 2013. Form 8843 must be filed if an individual is:

- present in the U.S. during 2013
- a nonresident alien
- present in the U.S. under F-1, F-2, J-1, or J-2 status.

Which means, regardless of income, international students are generally required to file their taxes. Please visit <u>Tax Information for International Students</u> webpage for more information.
