#### NOTES:

\*These major requirements may satisfy the university's core requirements.

- 2) Three of the five required 300-level courses must be from: PG 304, 305, 306, 308, 309, 310, 311, 312, 313, 314, 315, 316, 317, 318, 319, 344, 346, 353, 354, or 355.
- 3) Of the three units of upper division coursework required outside the first major, the Connections course will count for one unless it is used to meet a major requirement.
